WORK ELIGIBLE

Open to all artists, members and non-members.

TRADITIONAL SOFT PASTELS ONLY.

Original artwork only!

All works done in a school or under instructor supervision or copied from published photographs will be rejected.

All subjects and styles are eligible, from traditional to contemporary. Artwork must be predominantly pastel.

Size limit including frame: 48" in either direction.

Work must be firmly framed with screw eyes and strong wire, ready to hang. Work must be for sale...no NFS or POR. A 25% donation to the Pastel Society of America, Inc., will be accepted on all sales.

PROCEDURE FOR ENTRY

Send slides, slide entry form, entry fee and a **stamped self-addressed #10 business size envelope including sufficient return postage.** Entry must contain all required information listed, with each section filled out completely. **Regular Mail Only.**

SLIDES

All entries submitted must be on 35mm slides, 2" x 2" standard size in cardboard or thin plastic mount.

No glass or heavy plastic mount. No photographs.

Slides must be an accurate representation of your work. On each slide indicate top with an arrow, print your name, title and image size of painting.

Please do not attach gummed labels or affix anything to slides.

Declined slides will be returned with notification of jurors' decision.

SLIDES OF ACCEPTED WORK WILL BE KEPT FOR THE PASTEL SOCIETY'S ARCHIVES.

FEES

\$25/1 slide; \$35/2 slides; \$45/3 slides. Limit 3 entries. Fees are non-refundable. Make checks payable to the Pastel Society of America, Inc. Foreign and Canadian entry fees must include additional \$10 to cover bank charges.

Master Pastelists submit one 35mm slide for \$25.

ACCEPTED WORK

Artists of accepted work will receive an exhibition label. Label must be filled out and affixed to the back of painting, in upper right corner. Painting submitted must be identical to accepted slide. No substitutions permitted.
